A brief explanation of the parts of our attached Core Documents:

- ▶ **Our Core Basis and Mission Statement** – This explains how EDA PMA was formed in 2023 and the founding group's aims and intentions.
- ▶ **Our Core Values and Principles** – Here we set out our beliefs, based on common and natural laws and the rules of equity.
- ▶ **Our Mind Map** – This is an illustration of what we wish to achieve over a period of time.

This may include health, education, farming and other services.

Each town and village throughout East Devon, plus Lyme Regis, may be represented through regional sub-groups. Only a few areas are listed here, but we welcome other areas in East Devon too.

The **Mind Map** also illustrates other aspects, such as networking, organisation, website, group communications, to name but a few.

- ▶ **Our Constitution** – This sets out in more detail how we operate as EDA PMA. Here you will find details of our core aims, powers by which we may achieve our aims, the basis upon which each member's applications will be considered, creation of regional sub-divisions of EDA PMA and how they are to operate, among other matters.
- ▶ **Members Acceptable Conduct** – In effect, these are our rules which apply to all EDA PMA members. We prefer to step away from terms used in the public domain and adopt our own terms – hence Members Acceptable Conduct.
